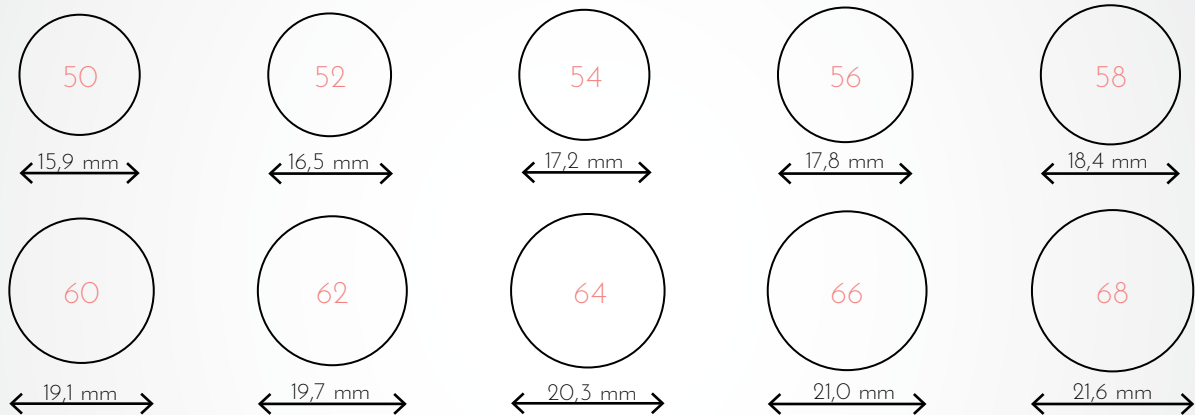


TIPS ON CHOOSING YOUR RING SIZE

- Make sure you are making your measurements in a warm environment at the end of the day.
- In case your knuckles are larger than your fingers, make your measurements manually (method 2) and choose the middle size. Make sure you are measuring a finger you intend to wear the ring on.
- In case you are choosing between two sizes, it is recommended to choose the larger one. Especially when the ring model you are choosing is wide.
- Ring size on your writing hand is usually half a size larger.
- Average female ring size is 52, average male ring size is 62.
- When choosing a ring for someone else, ask their relatives or friends for their ring size or better yet borrow one of their rings for measurement. Make sure you are borrowing a ring for the same finger they will wear their new ring on.

METHOD 1: measuring a sample ring

The scheme is showing different ring sizes. Print it in ratio 1:1. Place your sample ring on the circles below and compare in size. The line of the circle should fit the internal arch of the ring. In case you cannot choose between two sizes it is recommended that you choose a larger one.



You can also draw the insights of the ring on a blank piece of paper and measure the diameter of the circle. In case of intermediate size, choose a larger size.

METHOD 2: measuring a finger

With tensile cord or strap measure the extent of the finger closer to the palm. Wrap the strap around your finger and outline the junction. Compare the length of the strap from the beginning to the junction with lines below or just simply measure the length.
